Frequently asked questions:

Who is BTEC level 2 for?

This level is for students aged 14 to 16. Some students choose BTEC level 2 alongside International GCSEs as part of a 'blended' curriculum.

How does BTEC level 2 differ from other qualifications?

With BTEC level 2, the emphasis is firmly on practical skills. 40% of the BTEC curriculum is practical work, as opposed to exams. 20% of the BTEC curriculum can be tailored by learning centres to be regionally relevant. BTEC can also be taught in most languages, including Arabic.

Where can BTEC level 2 take you?

- Further study at age 16-18 students can then progress to study BTEC level 3, either on its own or alongside A levels. Students are able to apply their knowledge to real-life contexts.
- Employment BTEC level 2 helps to build employability skills for a student's chosen career. They will be more confident when it comes to job interviews and starting their first job.
